1. High Quality of Academic Experience

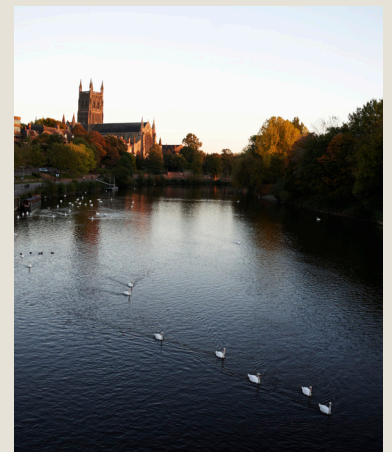
- Offers an extensive range of courses to inspire, enrich and educate

2. Location, location, location

- Located in the heart of England, the historic City of Worcester boasts dramatically beautiful sceneries
- With an approximate population of over 110,000 people, it is a safe, medium sized city and has been ranked 14th most desirable place to live out of hundreds of cities and towns in the UK in recent years
- Travel to other parts of the UK is extremely convenient via well-connected motorways and easily accessible public transport
- The city is also well connected to major airports: about 40 minutes away from Birmingham International Airport and about slightly more than 2 hours away from Manchester Airport and London Heathrow



3. An Inclusive Community

The university recognizes and embraces its role as an agent for social cohesion and inclusion and the contribution and impact that it has on students, staff and the community. The university has developed its campus, courses and identity to reflect these values. It has ensured that social inclusion is achieved through:

- The capacity to expand the innovative Learning Through Sport and Disability in Sport programmes now that the country’s first indoor arena specifically designed to cater for the needs of wheelchair athletes has been opened
- The opening of the Hive, Britain’s first joint public and university library, housing more than 275,000 books and over 12 miles of history records
- More than 10,000 students within a diverse student community including undergraduates, postgraduates, mature students and international students from almost 75 countries worldwide
- Becoming a ‘University of Choice’ for students, staff and partner organisations

4. State-of-the-Art Facilities and Resources

5. Multiple Campuses Within Walking Distance

- The University of Worcester campus includes a new multi-million pound City campus that houses our Worcester Business School and brand new city halls of residence.
- The St. John's campus which is located about a 15-20 minute walk away from the city centre boasts [high-quality halls of residence](#), brand new science laboratories, a modern and high-tech Digital Arts Centre, a new site for our internationally renowned [National Pollen and Aerobiology Research Unit](#) and an industry standard environmental test chamber, capable of replicating almost any climate in the world.
- The Riverside campus which is located in between the city campus and St. John's campus includes [The Garage](#) which houses studios and workshop spaces specifically intended for Art students. The adjacent [Riverside building](#) provides additional specialised space for the University's work in Sport, Performance and Dance. It also has a social learning and Internet space for students.



6. Providing Opportunities to Boost Employability

To-date, more than 90% of our graduates progress into work or further education within six months of graduating which is well above the national average.
